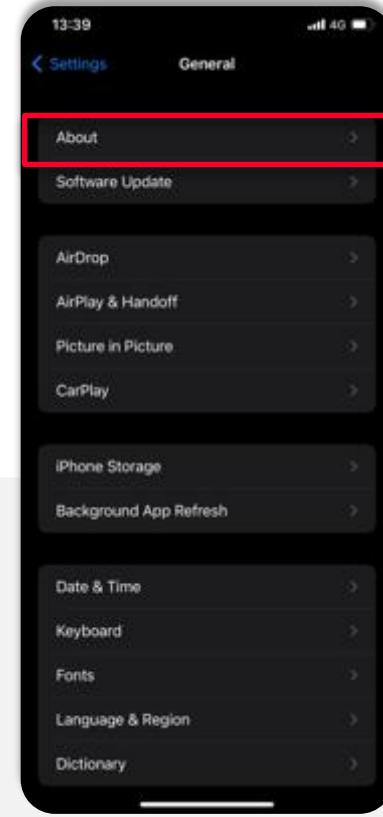
1 Go to "Settings"



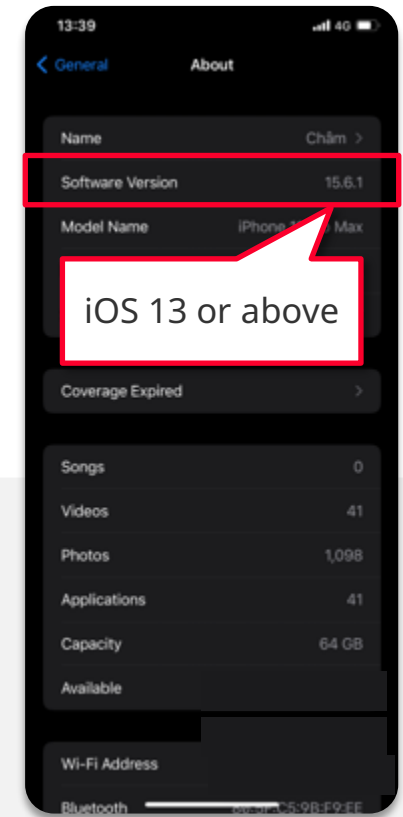
2 Select "General"

4 View OS version at "Version"



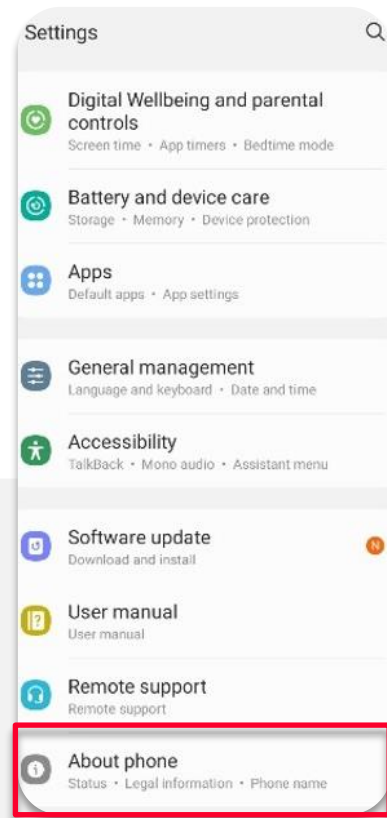

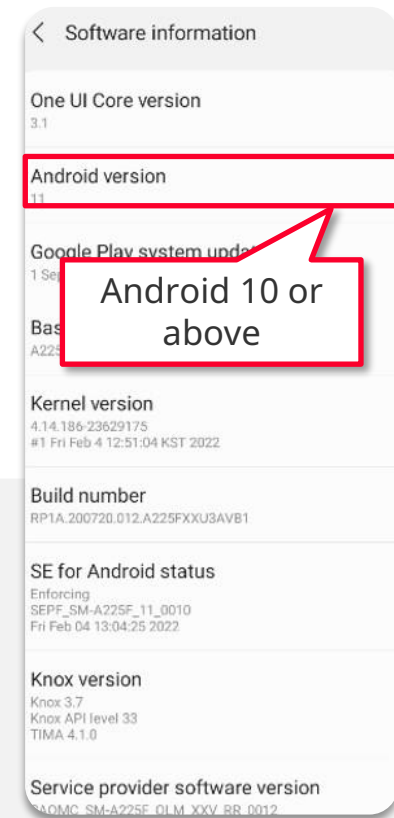

3 Select "Software information"

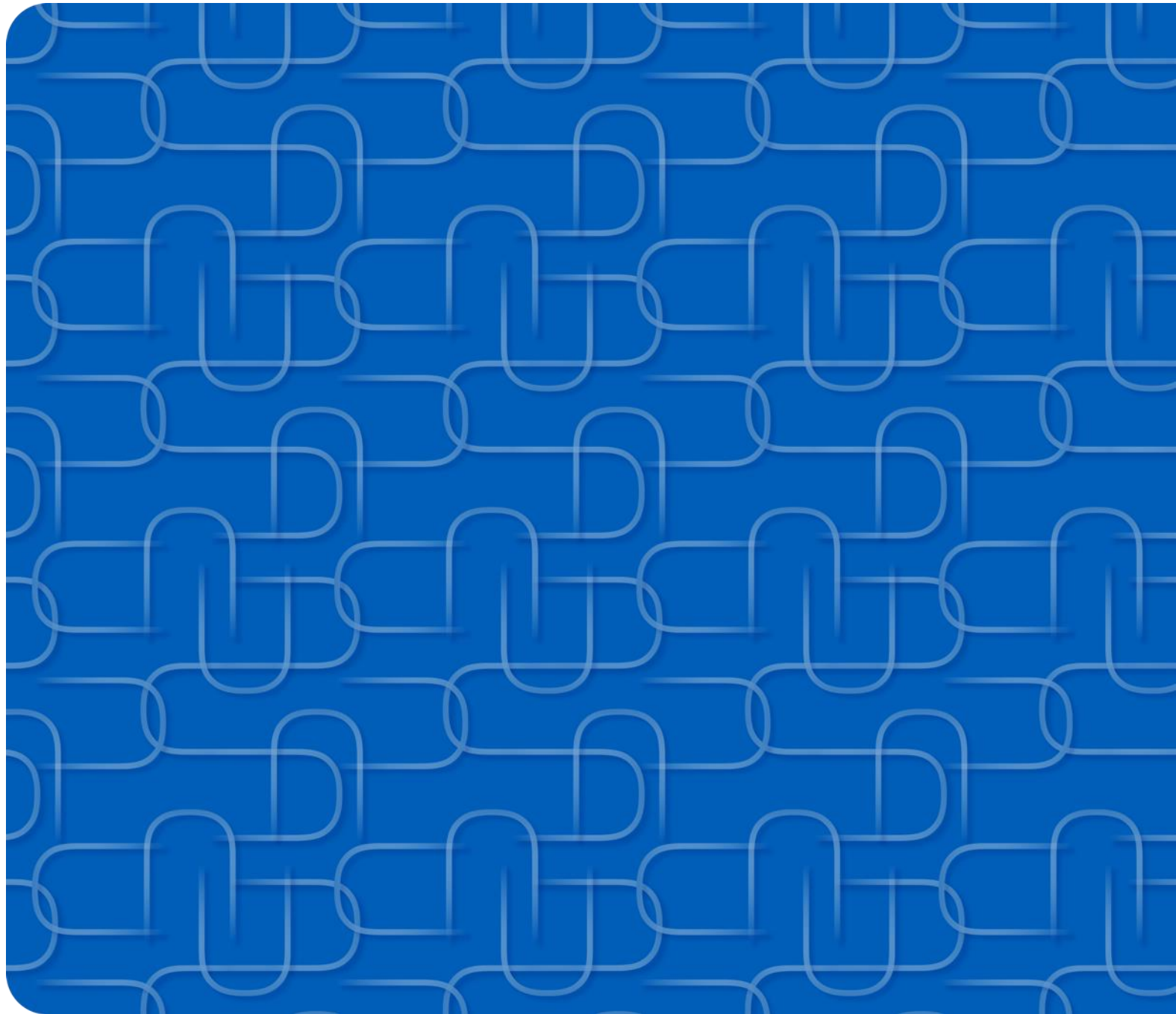

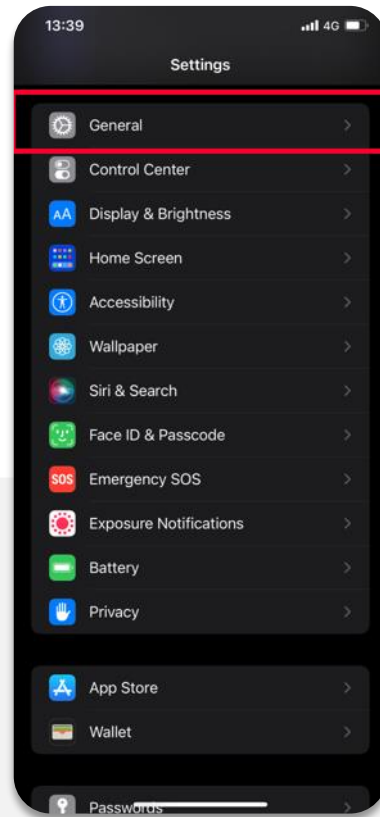

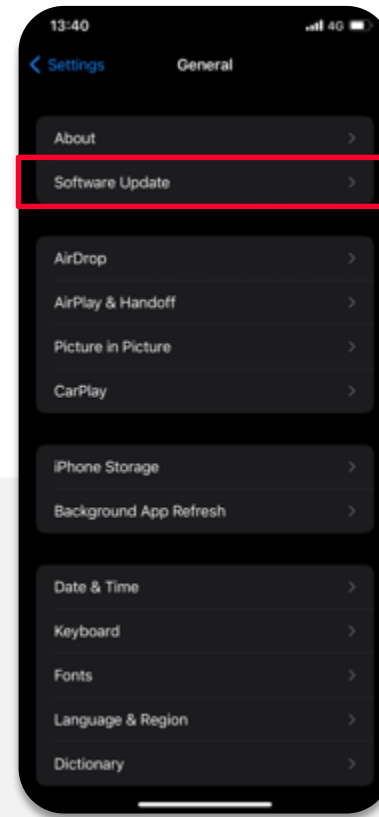

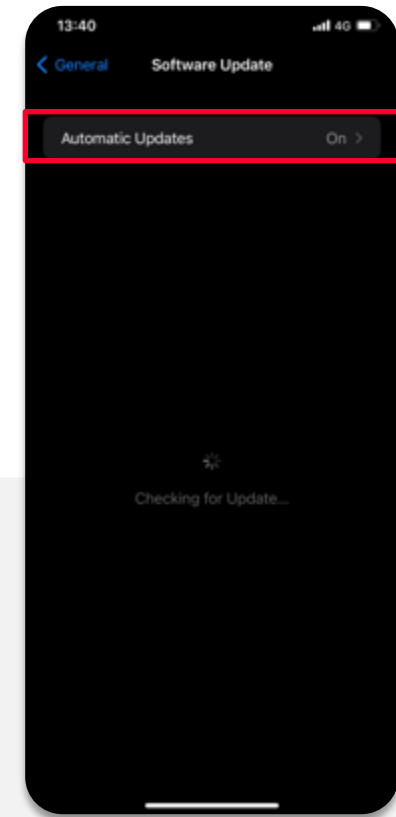

4 Select "Automatic Updates or "Download and Install"



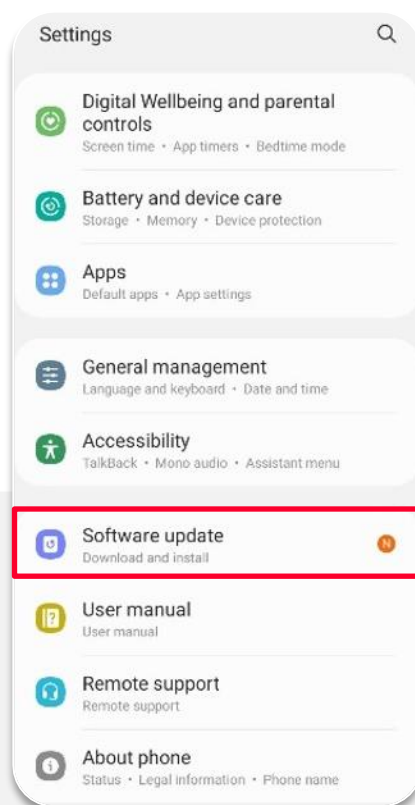

1 Go to "Settings"



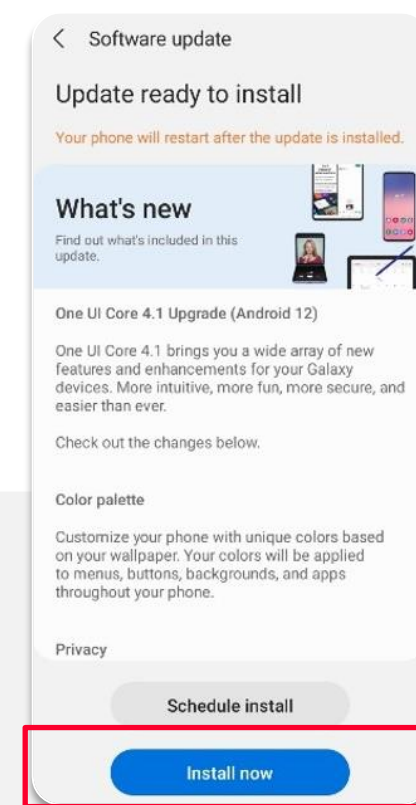
